Critic vows continued recall effort

Efforts to oust Oakland County are down, but not out, according to the West Bloomfield resident who initiated a recall last month.

"Wo're going to rework the
wording. Then we'll resubmit the
recall, but I can't say when," said
Susan Levine, who claims the
prosecutor should be custed from
office because he continued to
press charges against Dr. Jack
Kworkian under a state law that
is being appealled.

Levine made her pledge Friday shortly after three members of the Oakland County Election Com-mission unanimously voted to dismiss Levine's recall petition.

"It was a simple decision," said Probate Court Judge Sandra Sil-ver, chairwoman of the commis-sion. "The wording on the pro-posed recall petition was simply too vague."

In her petition submitted Dec.
21, Levino contended that
Thompson "engaged in a witch
hunt against Dr. (Jack) Kworkian" by continuing to press
charges under Michigan's law
against assisted suicide when the
ben had been ruled unconstitutional by two circuit court judges.
The Michigan Court of Appeals
Thurnday heard oral arguments
in the case calling inte question
the constitutionality of the law,
passed last year, making it a felony to assist in a suicide.
Levine and other backers of
Kevorkian — who insist assisted
suicide should be a matter of
choice — contend the law is vague, restrictive and unconstitutional.

Unal. While the law is being challenged, they contend Thompson is being vindictive and punctive — as well as wasting tax dollars — by continuing to press charges against Kevorkian, who has been present at 20 assisted suicides.

The attorney who represented the prosecutor before the election commission, however, said the re-call effort is misguided and doomed to falture. "Mr. Thompson believes in the right of the people to recall a public official," said Gerald Poisson, the prosecutor's former chief deputy who is now the county's corporation counsel. But in this case — the continued prosecution of Kevorkian — the law is clear and the prosecutor is fulfilling his legal obligation, he said.

Three days before the election commission threw out the recall petition, the prosecutor seemed to defy his critics by filing yet another charge against Keverkian, again claiming he violated the state's ban on assisted suicide.

At a press conference Tuesday,
Thompson announced he was filing a forth felony county against
Kevorkian, this one for his role in
the Nov. 22 death of All Khallii,
61, an Oak Brook, Ill., physician
who inhaled carbon monoxide gas
in Kevorkian's Royal Oak apartment.

At that news conference, Thompson reiterated his vow to prosecute anyone who violates existing state law.
"I make no apologies," Thompson said. "Open defiance and disregard of the law can not be condoned and must be rosisted."
Kevorkian's attorney, Geoffrey Fieger, called the prosecutor's fling charges an "unbelievably stupid thing."
