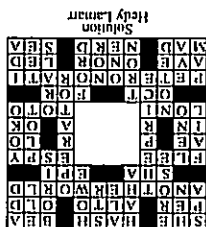

Buchanan is married and lives in Brooklyn, N.Y., with her husband, Gary, whom she became reacquainted with at a high-school reunion.

Tennis is one of Buchanan's favorite sports to play and she enjoys a very active lifestyle. She also loves to discover new restaurants.
