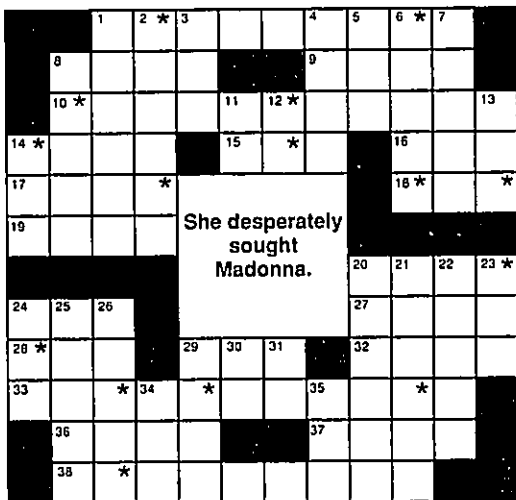


TV CROSSWORD

Glynnis O'Connor leaving 'ATWT'

Dear Candace: A friend of mine told me that the actress who plays Margo on "As the World Turns" has been fired. I can't believe it! I thought she really was talented. Can you tell me if this is true? —Rosemary in Michigan.

Dear Reader: Glynnis O'Connor took on the popular role of Margo on "As the World Turns" a year ago and even then was having second thoughts about it. Margaret Colin, who is married to Justin Deas (Buzz, "Guiding Light"), is in town, but it is doubtful she will return to the daytime scene.

There is also a good chance the show's executives will try to find a new actress to portray the character.
