## HERITAGE PARK SHELTER RESERVATIONS

At the Department of Special Services office, Farmington/Farmington Hills residents, in person, may reserve one of the three shelters within Heritage Park. **SOFTBALL REGISTRATION**

**CRIBbage TOURNAMENT**

## Community center to host Health-O-Rama

The Farmington Community Center has been chosen as a site for Project Health-O-Rama. This site is sponsored by Hospice of Southeastern Michigan as well as WXYZ-TV, Channel 7, and the United Health Organization.

Project Health-O-Rama offers free health screening to anyone 18 years of age or older.

The Farmington Community Center, 24705 Farmington Road, Farmington Hills, will offer

health screening to the community on Thursday, March 3, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Tests offered include height and weight, vision, blood pressure, glucose, counseling and referral, the optional blood test panel (22 tests-\$15), the new prostate specific antigen blood test (\$25) and colorectal cancer screening kit (\$4). Special tests at the community center will include hearing and glaucoma.

Volunteers from Hospice of Southeastern Michigan will participate in the testing. Project Health-O-Rama alerts individuals of possible health problems.
