HERITAGE PARK SHELTER RESERVATIONS
At the Department of Special Services office, Farmington/Farmington Hills residents, in person, may reserve one of the three shelters within Heritage Park. SOFTBALL REGISTRATION

There are 14 games plus playoffs for the men's and women's leagues, and 10 games plus playoffs for coed leagues. Registration fees are \$410 for resident/invitee, \$450 for open, and \$355 for coed. Children play a six-game schedule on Saturdays, beginning April 16, and practice one hour per week. Pre-registration fee of \$20 is required. Volunteer coaches are needed for this program.

Transportation will be provided using the school district buses. 
SPRING BREAK DAY CAMP
