That pays for 63 volunteer who visit about 400 disabled people in Oakland County, said program director Suzame Zerwick. The need for services and the need for volunteers is tremendous, "she said, adding that she could expand the

program's services dramatically if more money was available. Volunteers must meet income guidelines to qualify. Their in-come may not exceed 125 percent of the official poverty level.


