## Hills food-service management firm names regional director of operations

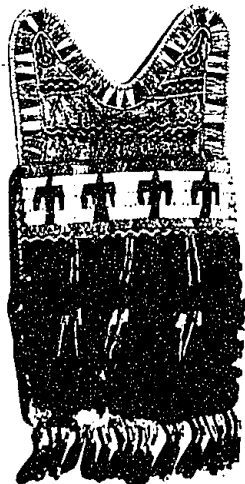
