

## ROYAL OAK (CONT.)

In 1992, the Royal Oak Senior Community Center won former President Bush's Point of Light Award for its community service. Indeed Royal Oak has services and facilities that one would expect from a city blended with a hometown including a City Sports Complex, ice arena and a golf course.

Long known for its stability and maturity, Royal Oak now is looking to the 1-696 project to bring new housing. The city has approved a \$10 million plan for the construction of apartments and condominiums at I-696 and Woodward. Current plans for the balance of the project include a hotel, offices, conference/convention space, cultural facilities and public open space. In keeping with its historic stability and concern for Royal Oak as a whole, the city owns enough of the land to assure that the growth is compatible with the area.
