Senior citizens are giving more back to their community than ever. That's what the numbers show when it comes to senior volunteers at the Mercy Center in Farmington Hilbs.


More than 300 senior volunteers along with representatives from local, county and state government bonored the hundreds of seniors who volunteer through the center in more than 40 programs throughout the year.
