Speaker tells of change from 'Yeshiva Girl' to an 'Orthodox feminist'

Blu Greenberg, lecturer and author of many books and articles on Jewish women and the Jewish family, will describe her odyssey, "From Mild-Mannered Yeshiva Girl to Orthodox Feminist," at Adat Shalom Synagogue Sisterhood's annual Donor Day Tuesday, May 3.

She is an Orthodox Jewish feminist who has dealt extensively with women's roles. She has been active in Jewish-Palestinian dialogue and other inter-group relations for the past two decades.

She is the author of "On Women and Judaism: A View from Tradition," "How to Run a Traditional Jewish Household" and "A Special Kind of Mother."

Listen to your heart when signs point to an attack

Signs such as tightening of the chest, pounding of the heart or soaring blood pressure may be symptoms of a serious health problem.

In Michigan, 77 percent of adults have at least one of the four major risk factors for heart disease. Those factors include smoking, high blood pressure,

high cholesterol and a sedentary lifestyle.

Michiganders rate higher than the national average for three of the risk factors.

The Cardiology Department at Botsford General Hospital will present "Listen to Your Heart," a free open house and educational

event for the entire family, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, April 30.

Activities will include free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings, body fat analysis, and counseling on risk factors, medication, nutrition and fitness. Special highlights for children will include a chance to listen to their heart, height and weight measure-

ment, tasty treats and prizes and a visit from Barney.

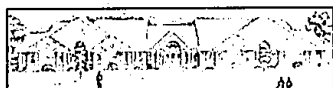

To respond classified ads in any category:

Call (810) 433-4800, enter 6161 when asked to enter a four-digit code. You may then:

- Press 1 for instructions
 - Press 2 to phone ads
 - Press 3 to enter a box number
- Listen to the easy-to-follow prompts which enable you to select ads based on county, city, vehicle make, pricing, home features, etc. The following options will help you through the network:
- Press 2 to go back to the previous message
