

## POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

## ■ DRUGS

A scale, rolling papers and a small bag of suspected marijuana were confiscated from a house on 10 Mile Road in Farmington Hills after a police search April 22. Police suspect a Farmington Hills man, 18, of selling marijuana, but he was not at the residence during the search.

Farmington Hills police arrested three Farmington Hills youths ages 21, 17 and 16 April 22 at a residence on Wheeler in Farmington Hills for possession of marijuana. They also confiscated \$311 in cash and two sets of scales.

A search of a vehicle and its passenger turned up 2.8 grams of marijuana during a traffic stop on Shiloh and Lakeway in the early morning of April 24. Farmington police pulled over a 1991 Ford Explorer after it was traveling with only its parking lights on. The driver was driving with a suspended license. Police found marijuana inside the dash and on a 16-year-old passenger.

## ■ DRUNKEN DRIVING

Farmington Hills police arrested a Rogers City man, 24, for drunken driving at 1:30 a.m. April 23 on eastbound M-102 near Orchard Lake in Farmington Hills. Officers noticed a 1993 Ford Taurus weaving down the road and pulled

the driver over. His preliminary breath test indicated a blood alcohol level between .12 and .13 percent. A level of .1 percent is considered too drunk to drive.

Farmington Hills police arrested a Farmington Hills woman, 30, for drunken driving after her black 1994 Pontiac Grand Am was involved in an accident on eastbound Nine Mile at 10:13 p.m. April 24. A preliminary breath test indicated a .23 percent blood alcohol level.

## ■ AUTO THEFT

The passenger window was broken on a gold 1994 Ford Explorer parked on Scott in Farmington Hills April 23, but its alarm sounded, apparently scaring off the would-be car thief.

A black 1991 Honda Accord worth \$13,000 was stolen April 20-23 from Sunline Acure on Grand River in Farmington Hills.

The driver's side door locks were pried open and the steering column damaged (\$1,000) in an attempt to steal a white 1992 Chevy Blazer from the Detroit News-Press warehouse on Crestview in Farmington Hills April 24.

A green 1994 Ford Ranger pickup worth \$11,500 with the keys in the ignition was stolen from a residence on Tucker in Farmington Hills April 25-26.

## ■ BREAK-INS

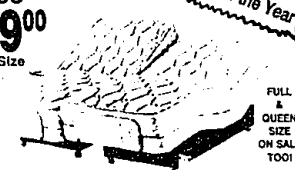
