Oakland County ranks as the third wealthiest county in the nation among counties with populations in excess of one million. Outdoor recreation opportunities close to home include over 400 lakes, five ski areas, 27 public fishing sites, 45 public golf courses and about 80,000 acres of public recreation.

Significant entertainment and sports venues include Pine Knob and Meadowbrook outdoor theatres, Pontiac Silverdome — Detroit Lions, Palace of Auburn Hills — Detroit Pistons home, Cranbrook Institutions and the Detroit Zoo.
