Mooney and Asselin firmly believe in making Twiggs & Blossom's as cus-tomer-oriented as possible. They do this in many ways, from delivering their arrangements to nine metropolitan counties to maintaining a welcoming attitude towards all customers.

"We want people to walk through just to experience our store," Mooney said. -We cater to customers who come in to see flowers they've never seen before, customers who want to buy a single stem every week and customers who place

large orders regularly.
"We are a floral boutique," Mooney added. "We want people to walk through out place like they would an art gallery."

Visitors will see unique flowers, unusual containers and topiaries, wreaths, unusual pieces of patio furniture, bird baths and more. They'll watch Mooney at work creating an arrangement. He and his other staff don't hide in a back room workspace. They work where customers can watch.

They'll also decorate people's homes for the holidays. They make special arrangements, such as in a toilet training seat for a baby shower. They do arrangements for parties and weddings, only doing one wedding a day so everything is perfect for that bride and groom.

Twigs & Blossom's also caters to the

community. Its owners purchase items from local growers whenever they can. They use only recyclable packaging with soy ink and they support many community organizations. These include Avon Players. Rochester Symphony Orchestra, Rochester Community Schools and Oakland University's Meadow Brook Hall.

Although Mooney and Asselin are owners of Twiggs & Blossom's, others work with them to make the boutique a success — Jerry Dunsizer and Catherina "Kitty" Odekerken.

Both Mooney and Dunsizer are members of the American Institute of Floral Designers, earning this distinction by passing several professional tests of their creative skills.

While Asselin grew up in the floral industry, he concentrates more on the marketing end of the business. He also manages the two partners* new business, Penn & Paige, Ltd. Located only a few stores north of the floral boutique, Penn & Paige eaters to customers seeking unusual stationery and paper lines. It also has state-of-the-art equipment to help clients design the typeface for their stationery and invitations.

Many customers want to know if there really is a Twiggs and a Blossom, according to Mooney and Asselin. The answer is yes, although they didn't come about until after the floral boutique opened.

They are the owners' two Cocker

Spaniel puppies, who will be allowed to roam the stores as the dogs mature.
