

2nd House run expected

U.S. Rep. Joe Knollenberg, R-Bloomfield Township, is expected to announce Saturday that he is a candidate for a second term in the U.S. House of Representatives from Michigan's 11th Congressional District.

The 11th District includes Farmington and Farmington Hills.

Knollenberg will make his announcement at the grand opening of his new campaign headquarters at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 7. The Knollenberg for Congress campaign headquarters is at 27877 Orchard Lake Road in the Orchard Twelve Plaza.

The anticipated announcement by Knollenberg will be the highlight of the headquarters' grand opening which will serve as an open house for friends and supporters. Refreshments will be served and the public is invited to attend.

The Knollenberg campaign headquarters will mark the second stint for the Knollenberg political team at this location.

In 1992, Knollenberg had his campaign office in the same shopping center at 12 Mile and Orchard Lake. Members of Congress must face election every two years.


