## Award winners perform

The first- and second-place winners in the Farmington Musicale's annual Awards for Musical Excellence competition performed in a recital May 4 at the Farmington Hills Branch Library.

Vocal judge Anna Speck gave the first-place award for musical excellence to Melanie Downie in the 11th-12th grade division. Monica Moore received second place. Juliet Petrus was chosen for first place in the 9th-10th grade division, and Elizabeth Michalo placed second.

String judge Roxanne Oliver gave cellist Caryn Vermiglio and Tara Szczepielski, violinist, first and second awards in the 7th-8th grade division. In the 9th-10th grade division, first place was taken by cellist Tricia Rhiew, Laura Avers, also a cellist, received second. In the 11th-12th grade contest, violinist George Nagrant was awarded first place

and Carrie Earl, viola, placed second.

Wind, brass and percussion were judged by Pat Authement. In the 7th-8th grade division, he chose flutist Anne Nagrant for first place, and LeAnne Shultz, French horn, for second.

The 9th-10th grade auditions were won by Jonathan Perry, first, and Tricia Rhiew, second. Hee Lee received second place in the 11th-12th grade competition.
