

Cranbrook's House and Gardens Auxiliary, a volunteer organization that maintains the home and gardens of Cranbrook's founders in Bloomfield Hills, won four major awards for their exhibit at the 1994 Ann Arbor Flower and Garden show recently.

For the second consecutive year, Cranbrook's exhibit was honored as the Best Landscape Design by the Metropolitan Detroit Landscape Passociation. In addition, the suxiliary won the Mayor's Trophy for 1994, first place for plant societies landscape and a design excellence award for plant societies.

The exhibit, titled "Sunshine and Shadows," included a sun garden and shade garden, inspired by Cranbrook's 40 acres of gardens. The "sunshine" portion

included a formal arrangement of bright hybrid blooms, accented by a bench, sundial and rose trees. The "shadow" section featured form, trillium, moss and mitterwort gleam.

Volunteers fabricated a stone wall from Styrofosm to separate the two gardens and an amelanchier tree and small pool provided diditional accents.




