STARS IN THE PARK

Concert begins at 8 p.m. There is no charge. **DAY CAMP AT MERCY CENTER** Camp Wonna-Bee, ages 6-7, and Camp When-A-Wonna, ages 8-10, will be this summer at Mercy Center. There are eight one-week sessions scheduled beginning June 20. Camp hours are 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The camp theme will be active, including team sports,

games, swimming, challenge course, crafts and field trips. Campers should bring a sack lunch and swimwear each day. Pre-registration fee of \$70 per child is required.

WALK MICHIGAN Enjoy Heritage Park when you participate in "Walk Michigan" on the various trails of the park. Individuals will be eligible for a drawing for prizes at the local level, as well as a chance to win a trip for two to Mackinac Island for Labor Day. Registration is taken on site the night of the walk. The walks will be every Thursday evening beginning at

6:30 p.m. through Aug. 11. Participants should meet at the Day Camp Center. There is no fee for this program.

SAFETY TOWN REGISTRATION Registration for Safety Town will be 9:30-11:30 a.m. Saturday, June 4, at the Farmington Hills City Hall council chambers, 11 Mile and Orchard Lake roads. Use the east entrance to the building. Registration is taken on a first-come, first-served basis. You may register children from one other family only besides your own. (No exceptions.) Fee is \$50 per child. **NATURE DISCOVERY WAGON** Pre-registration for children ages 3-6 and a parent or grandparent is

being accepted for a program that provides a tour of Heritage Park's natural sights, sounds and textures of spring. Participants will ride on a hay wagon with special stops along the way. The evening ends with a camp fire and roasting of marshmallows. Fee of \$5 per person will be accepted for the Monday, June 6, or the Wednesday, June 22, program. Program runs 7-8:30 p.m.

CHILDREN'S TOURS Your child can discover the fun-filled locations within southeast Michigan during this weeklong program. Children will visit both educational and recreational sites. Children ages 6-8 can regis-

ter for seasons that run June 27 to July 1, July 11-15 and July 26-29. Seasons for the 9- to 12-year-olds are June 20-24, July 6-8 and July 18-22. Fee is \$75 per person, per session. Children should bring a sack lunch.

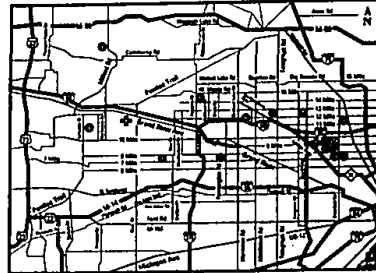
