

# Elementary students skate for Juvenile Diabetes

A fund-raiser spearheaded by Hillside Elementary School for the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation recently raised \$10,000.

"It was much bigger than we ever expected," according to Frances Gardner, who helped organize "Kids Helping Kids Skate for a Cure" at U.S. Blades in West Bloomfield.

About 120 students raised approximately 150 pledges. Area businesses also showed support, providing more than \$4,000 worth of prizes for the skaters.

"The Farmington community was so incredible," Gardner said. "No one said 'no' to us."

The event raised money and taught the children about juvenile diabetes. Two Hillside students have juvenile diabetes. Bill Gullickson, a Detroit Tigers pitcher who was diagnosed with juvenile diabetes when he was 20, visited the school and spoke to the children about the disease.

## Sarah Fisher garden party to benefit abused, neglected children

The St. Vincent and Sarah Fisher Center presents "La Fete au Jardin" - The Garden Party. It is from 2-6 p.m. Sunday, June 6, on the Center grounds at 27400 Twelve Mile in Farmington Hills.

Co-chaired by Gail and Dick Furtan, WKQI-FM radio host, and Bill Bonds, WXYZ-TV 7 news anchor, the event benefits the center's programs for abused and neglected children.

Attracting more than 1,100 community leaders, the seventh annual Garden Party continues the tradition of gourmet appetizers, entrees and desserts prepared by chefs from over 55 of the area's finest restaurants, fine wines from around the world and music

from nationally acclaimed jazz artist Alexander Zonje.

The event sponsored by Huntington Banks, also features a fine wine auction of rare and collectible wines auctioned in 60 minutes by event chairperson Ed Jonna, owner of the Merchant of Vino.

The center's "Beyond Peanut Butter and Jelly" cookbook, featuring favorite recipes from Garden Party chefs, will be available for a donation to the center.

For 65 years, St. Vincent and Sarah Fisher Center has helped support children and families in crisis.

The center's six programs include residential treatment, spe-

cial needs adoption, treatment foster care, Marillac pregnancy services, Seton Community Pre-school and Infant Child Care, and Transitions residential program for mothers and infants.

Overall these programs provide comprehensive services to 250 infants, youth and families on a daily basis.

This year, the center celebrates the 150th anniversary of its founder, the Daughters of Charity, who came to Detroit in 1845 to open one of the city's first hospitals, now Providence Hospital.

Within two years, the sisters responded to community need establishing the St. Vincent Orphan

Asylum. In 1869, they began a program for unwed and/or deserted mothers and their children.

The doors of the St. Vincent and Sarah Fisher Center were officially opened in Farmington Hills in 1929 to house existing programs and provide additional quality care and treatment to the community's children and families in need.

Tickets to the Garden Party are \$90 per person, \$300 for patrons, which includes two tickets, and \$500 for benefactors, which includes four tickets.
