# Job prospects looking better

Positive employment prospects are expect-ed for the Detroit area this summer, based on company responses to Southfield-based Man-power Inc.'s Employment Outlook Survey for

ed for the Detroit area this aummer, based on company responses to Southfield-based Manpower Inc.\* Employment Outlook Survey for the third quarter.

"Plans to recruit more workers during July, August and September are expressed by 30 percent of local businesses surveyed while 13 percent anticipate amailer staffs," said Jeanne Heller of Manpower.

"Additionally, 64 percent expect current workforce levels to pravail and the remaining 3 percent are uncertain.

"Hiring activity typically peaks during the summer months," Heller said. "In our area, the outlook was somewhat better three months ago, when 35 percent of those interviewed projected increased hiring and 10 percent predicted cutting back. Last summer, 25 percent reported planned reductions."

This summer, lob prospects appear best in durable goods manufacturing, services and public administration. Cutabecks are planned in finance/insurance/rsal seates, education and construction. Mixed intentions are voiced by wholesale/retail merchants and non-durable goods manufacturers.

On a national scale, the survey shows a clear continuation of increasing smployment with hiring at its highest level in five years. A total of 29 percent plan to increase smployment and just 7 percent expect workforce reductions. Another 61 percent will remain at current levels and 3 percent are not yet certain.
