Burke-Orwig

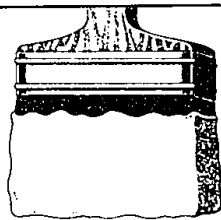

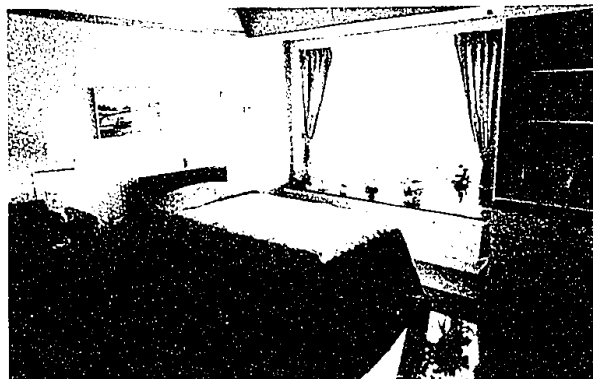
