est component — literally — the huge drain that will go underneath Kendallwood from Artwick to Tulipwood. That part of the project has brought the most controversy.

But Zorza said that now that Ric-Man Construction of Sterling Heights is on the job, residents have not grumbled about the in-

convenience. And the dry weather hasn't hurt either.

"We had given him (contractor) a one-week extension because of some problems early on," Zorza said. "But I think he's going to finish the first stage by the original deadline (July 4)."

The contract calls for bonuses for finishing each of the three sec-

tions of Kendallwood on time. So far, crews have moved an average of 120-130 feet a day, better than expected, Zorza said.

"It's been very busy, but very smooth so far," said Steve Mancini, president of Ric-Man. "There is a lot of coordination in a job this size. It's unusual to have a job of this size in a residential

neighborhood. It's a sensitive job."

Longtime Kendallwood resident and former school board member Dick Wallace said he was impressed with how the work crews handle the heat and do their jobs.

"They're totally professional," Wallace said, adding that one of

the steam shovel operators had been given the nickname "the surgeon" by residents because he was so exact.

"Except for the inconvenience of having a water main go out while I was taking a shower, it hasn't been bad," Wallace said. "They had it fixed within an hour."

The project is designed to relieve flooding that has plagued the subdivision over the years. Flooding in 1989 and 1991 caused severe damage to several houses.

The entire project is scheduled for completion in mid-October except for final asphalt capping, which is scheduled for next spring.

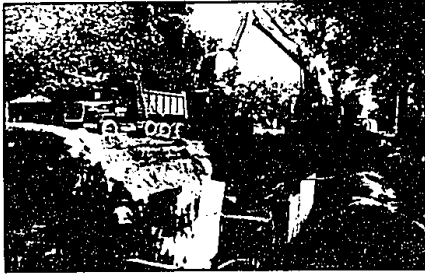
