

# POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

## FIRES

Farmington Hills firefighters from stations 2 and 3 put out a fire in the basement of a house of Sky Drive East in Farmington Hills at 9:38 p.m. July 4. Firefighters discovered arcing wires to the electrical box and cut wires. Damage was estimated at \$10,000 to the house and \$10,000 to contents.

Hills firefighters from stations 2 and 4 put out a fire in the roof of a house on Pine Cone Drive in Farmington Hills at 7:51 a.m. July 5. Lightning struck the roof, starting the fire, which caused \$25,000 in damage to the house and \$10,000 in damage to contents.

## THEFT

A ladies diamond ring worth from \$9,750 to \$15,000 was stolen from a residence on Skye Drive East in Farmington Hills June 24.

A wooden subdivision sign (\$200) was stolen from 13 Mile in Farmington Hills July 2. The sign said "Rolling Oaks" and had an oak leaf design.

A diamond-cut cellular phone, two tennis rackets and a sports bag (\$1,000 total) were stolen from a red 1994 Acura Integra parked on Fox Club Drive in Farmington Hills between June 30 and July 1.

A billfold with \$700 in cash was stolen from the Clarion Hotel on 12 Mile in Farmington Hills July 2-3.

A Farmington Hills woman, 30, a Redford man, 32, a Telford, Tenn. man, 31, a Detroit man, 28, and a Garden City man, 29, were arrested for possession of narcotics paraphernalia and loitering in a place where illegal drugs were being used at the Bahama Motel on Grand River in Farmington Hills July 2. A Livonia man, 31, was taken to Botsford Hospital for a drug overdose. Hills police found drug paraphernalia and traces of cocaine in plastic bags and tubes.

Farmington Hills police arrested a Farmington Hills woman, 27, for driving under the influence of cocaine July 4. The woman was arrested as she drove east on 11 Mile near Drake in a gray 1992 Toyota Celica. Police initially tested the woman for alcohol before she admitted using cocaine.

## CONCEALED WEAPON

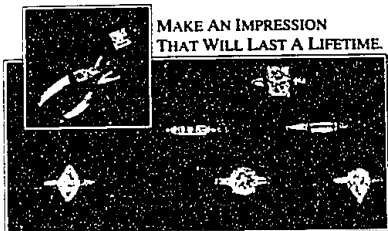

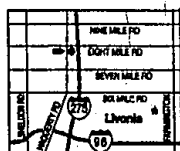

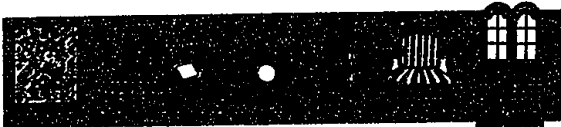
