will meet with groups, including condominium owners and seniors, to explain the plan. Street im-provements and special assess-ments affect condo owners and apartment dwellers, Lauhoff said.

"If the city is in there replacing the street, you're going to see an increase in your rent or mainte-nance assessment," he said.

Marketing Communications in Southfield is going to work with city staff to compile information and send out a mailing. The firm already helps the city with its newsletter.


