Cleaners among tops

Venus Cleaners, owned by Farmington Hills resident George Benien, has been ranked 96 among the state's fastest growing companies in the 1994 Michigan Private 100.

The company specializes in

cleaning and restoring clothing and all household items, including draperies and blinds, that have been damaged by smoke, fire or water.

Venus Cleaners bought out a major competitor, Palace Quality Cleaners, in 1991. Sales volume increased at that time, and 12 more people were hired to handle the extra work.

Benien attributes the company's success to the importance placed on the details of the industry, saying that all employees "must learn the importance of properly handling each item that is processed."

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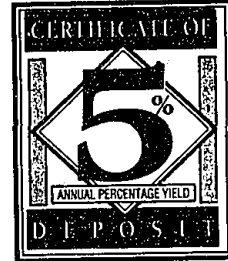

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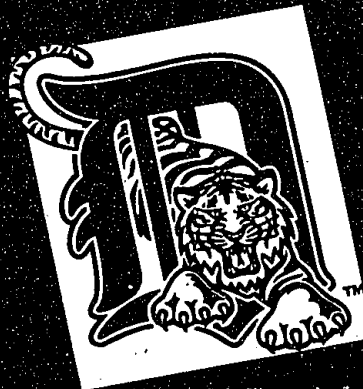
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
