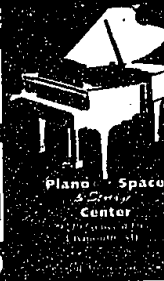
Raddata of Farmington Hills were awarded the doctor of veterinary medicine degree from Michigan State University's College of Veterinary Medicine.

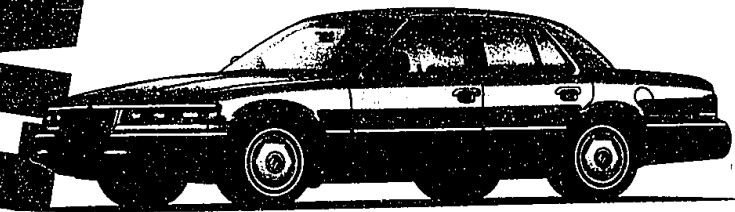

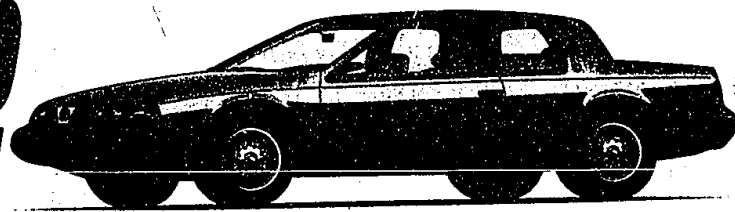
