

When Christine Paoli gave her 12-year-old daughter, Rebecca Savarese, daily instructions on how to thwart a possible abduction, she never really thought it would happen.

Nor did she think that her daughter was really listening.

But, her persistence paid off.
On her way to school one Priday morning, a man pulled a gun on Savarese and tried to force her into his truck.

Quick-witted Savarese folled his attempt by pretending to hyperventilate, and eluded him when she took off her backpack to make breathing easier. The suspected gunman was later arrested. He also was swalting prosecution for the murder of a local 12-year-old Pittsfield boy and may be

linked to other child abductions.




