## Farmington teams look like possible contenders

North Farmington has a younger, less experienced tennis team after losing 11 seniors (its starters) who helped the Raiders post a 12-1 record last year.

But they aren't conceding anything just yet and plan to put another competitive team on the courts, according to coach Norm Stanzialewski.

"Our doubles were dominated by seniors and right now they're not as strong as last year," he said.

"We have a lot of new players seeing varsity action, but I think we have enough depth to put together some good chemistry."

The strength of the team is at No. 1 and 2 singles with senior Allison Walton and sophomore Lauren Jones, respectively.

Walton was 14-3 at No. 2 singles and takes over for Kari Jones, who is now playing for Vassar College. Jones had an 18-3 record at No. 3 singles.

"Allison has been a very productive player in her four years on the team," Stanzialewski said. "Lauren is a steady, strong, consistent player."

Junior Amy Marks and freshman Sarah Hand will rotate between Nos. 3 and 4 singles.
