Fazzino's view of a New York neighborhood features begels, pickles and fish walking down a bustling street, filled with narrow buildings that house different offices and businesses. The World Trade Center towers stand in the

horizon.

A circus, a soccer game and doctors' offices are among his other subjects, all almost literally jumping with color. Such cartoon royalty as the Flintstones, the Jetsons, Olive Oyl and Betty

Boop have been the focus of Far-nino works as well.
When Farzino does a serigraph of a city, he likes to include such features as lat restaurants, nota-ble places and entertainment.

Fazzino's outdoor scenes include hot air balloons, and someciude hot air balloons, and some-times reppelins. They are cheerily decorated, and may carry messag-es. The artist puts them in for color and to help balance a work. "I'm scared of hot air balloons, to tell you the truth. I find that

the pieces artistically are sort of bottom-beavy."
Farzino's art takes many forms, such as books and sculptures. He has made, or is making, artistic contributions to benefit Special Olympics, the Maks-s-Wish Foundation and Very Special Arts, among other organizations. Celabrilles own some of Farzino's pieces. He made a work of the Lincoln Center for Luciano Paverotti, and one of the Special Olympics for Maria Shriver and Arneld Schwarzenegger.

The style Farrino developed has a touch of the paper-folding art of origami.

He first makes an original painting, which is then printed and cut by hand. Each work is one of a kind, as the pieces are raised, cut and folded differently to make the three-dimensional effect. A special, non-acid glue that won't burn the prints is used. Giltter is sometimes added for a subtle shimmering effect.

Fazzino's interest in art began with a Junior Achievement project that involved making collagre.

He later studied at the Parson's School of Design and earned a bacholor of fine arts degree at the School of Visual Arts.

As a street artist in the late 1970s, Parzino depicted diverse neighborhoods and yearly events of his native New York City. He became interested in presenting other cities from around the countries.
