HUNTER'S SAFETY

In accordance with Michigan State law, participation is required in a certified Hunter's Safety Clinic for individuals who were born after Dec. 31, 1959, and wish to buy their first hunting license. The course will meet from 6-9 p.m. Oct. 17, 19, and 21 and from 9 a.m. to noon Oct. 22. Participants must attend all sessions, be 12 years of age by March 31, 1991, and pass a written test to qualify for the certificate. Pre-registration fee of \$5 per person is required.

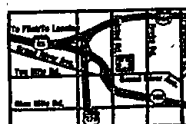

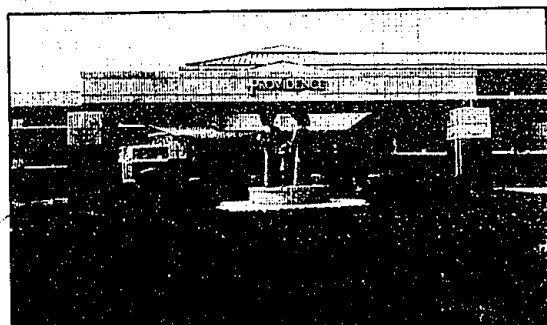

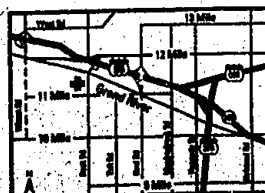
