

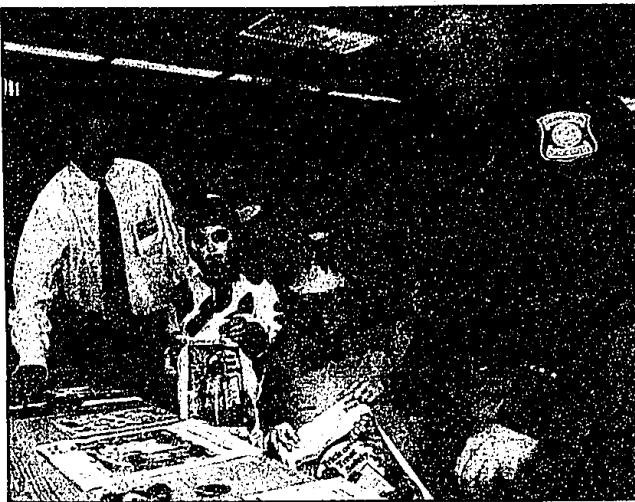
Halloween safety's in the bag

The Farmington Public Safety Department will again be going throughout the community on Halloween night in the Crime Prevention van, passing out "Trick or Treat Safely" bags.

Each bag will contain a 911 Coloring Book, a Junior Police Badge, and a bag of potato chips. Also, in cooperation with Kmart, the department will provide Halloween Old-Slacks. The sticks are used to help illuminate the children as they go door to door at night.

Farmington police Commander Chuck Lee also offers these Halloween safety tips:

- Costumes should be loose fitting and shouldn't be too long to avoid tripping.
- Consider using makeup instead of a mask. Children can breathe easier and their vision will not be blocked.
- Outfits should be brightly colored.
- Never go into anyone's home, and only go to those homes that are well-lighted.
- Never travel alone: Always take a friend or parent along.
- Parents should establish a time for when children should return home.
- Parents should make sure children exit on the curb side of the vehicle when dropping them off.
- Feed children their favorite meal beforehand. That way they won't be hungry and tempted to eat any candy before they return
