Voters in Oakland County and across Michigan will go to the polls Tuesday, November 8, 1994 to elect candidates competing for partisan and nonpartisan positions. As a voter education project, the Leagues of Women Voters in Oakland County and the League of Women Voters in Michigan have prepared this Guide. The League of Women Voters is a national, nonpartisan organization established in 1920 to encourage citizen participation in government. The Leagues of Women Voters in Oakland County contacted the candidates and compiled this Voter Guide to enable residents of Oakland County to cast a more informed vote. Candidates' responses are printed as submitted and have not been edited except in cases where the replies exceeded the stated word limitations. Slographical information was limited to 75 words and responses to each question was limited to 75 words. Partisan candidates are listed in the order in which their parties historically first registered as a Michigan political party. All others are in alphabetical order.
