One poster deplota acts or explonage, including Hitler pos-tage stamps Allies used to demo-ralize Germans through the mail and instructions smuggled by the

French Resistance on gum wrappers detailing how to derail enemy trains.

The exhibit runs along an outer wall and into a conference room. People can view the entire collection, except at those times when the meeting room is occupied, Smith said.

"I'm very interested to see what the community's reaction is to the presentation." Curd said. "We've got a year, Veterans Day to Veterans Day."

The Farmington area commemorative committee has also asked

veterans and their families to write about their own World War II experiences. The outpouring has been tremendous, Curd said.


