Michigan's real estate transfer tax of 0.75 percent takes effect Jan. 1. The new tax was approved as part of the ballot proposal passed by voters March 15.

The tax will be collected from the seller at the time the deed is passed from seller to buyer. The tax is accounted for in closing documents prepared as part of the sale.
