"She was an excellent seamstress and sewed baby garments for the royal family in Holland," Georgina LeClair said.

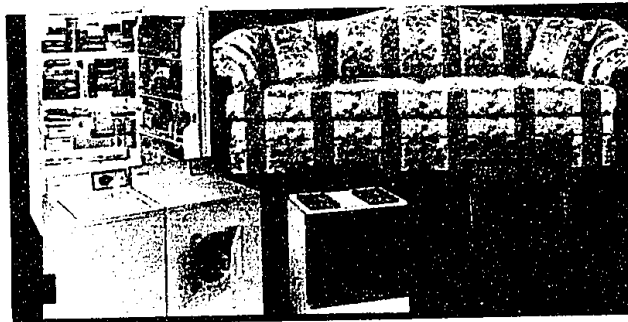
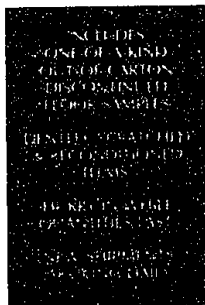
A surprise birthday party was held in her honor on Nov. 25 at the Farmington Oaks Apartments where she lives with her daughter, Elizabeth.
