al program for the Muscular Dystrophy Association. The green cardboard shamrocks that say "out of my heart comes a shamrock" are sold at business establishments for \$1. The cus-tomer signs his/her name on the shamrock, and they are dis-played on the walls.

"Our customers have been very supportive — they are buy-

ing the shamrocks like crary. It's really nice to see the enthusianm for helping MDA," salon owner Diane Barringer said.

The Muscular Dystrophy Association is a national voluntary health agency working to defeat 40 neuromuscular diseases through programs of worldwide research, comprehensive medical programs and professional and public health education.

In the Metro-Detroit area, MDA supports clinics at Detroit Children's Hospital and at the Michigan Institute for Neurological Disorders (MIND) in Farmington Hills.
