Madonna U plans upgrade

Madonna University has em-barked on a \$5 million project to upgrade technology and expand and maintain facilities at its cam-pus on Schoolcraft at Levan in Livonia.

The improvements — which in-clude purchase and remodeling of the former Pfister Co. building across Levan — will be funded by a February bond issue that Ma-donna officials believe is the first by a private, four-year university in Michigan to include a stan-dard & Poor's investment rating.

The "A-" rating benefits the university by lowering the inter-est rate paid over the 10-year life of the bonds, said Leonard Wil-helm, Madonna vice president for business and finance.

"The bond issue also allows us to pursue these projects now, rather than waiting for a benefactor or finding money in the gen-eral fund budget," Wilhelm said.

The bond issue is the first for Madonna, the second-largest Catholic university in Michigan. Other state schools including the

University of Detroit-Mercy, Mar-grove College and Aquinas Col-lege have issued bonds.

Sister Mary Franciene, Ma-donna president, said the largest portion of the project, about \$2 million, will be devoted to techno-logical improvements. These in-clude replacement of the universi-ty telephone system and installa-tion of a campus-wide fiber-optic network and computer hardware/software systems.

The upgrades will allow in-teractive transmission of voice, data and video information from a central point to classrooms on and off campus.

New technology is needed "to prepare students for tomorrow's workforce," Sister Franciene said.

"Maintenance and other im-provements to the physical plant

are necessary for a campus where most of the buildings are 30 years old."

Madonna enrollment has grown steadily over the past decade to 4,155, university officials said.

The university bought the 12,000-square-foot Pfister building last December for \$1.1 million. Renamed the Maertens Building, it is on the northeast corner of Schoolcraft and Levan, adjacent to the Angelo DiPonito building already occupied by uni-versity staff.

The food distributor moved its employees to a new location in Plymouth on Jan. 31.

Madonna will begin renova-tions of the building this spring to accommodate classrooms, offices and conference rooms. The heat-ing/cooling and lighting systems will also be replaced.

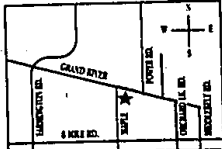

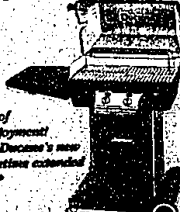

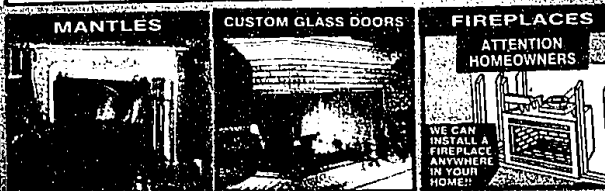
