## Health-O-Rama here

**M**ercy Health Services corporate headquarters, 34606 W. 12 Mile Road, west of Farmington Road, will be the site of a Health-O-Rama from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday, April 6.

At the Health-O-Rama site, Care Choices HMO will provide the Farmington area with a variety of free and low-cost health screening tests and educational materials. Anyone over 18 years of age may participate.

The following tests and services will be available: height and weight, vision, glaucoma, blood pressure, health education information, counseling and referral, colorectal cancer screening kit (\$5), a blood panel of 22 tests (\$16), and a prostate specific antigen blood test (\$25).

Project Health-O-Rama will be available at 97 sites throughout southeast Michigan until April 13. Last year, nearly 37,000 people were screened.

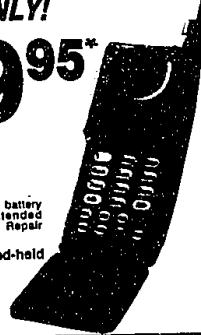
