The murder of a prisoner at the Riverside Correctional Facility in Ionia has a Farmington Hills con-

William Frederick Jr., 40, was killed April 11 in a stabbing in the prison recreation yard. The killing, the first murder in a Michigan prison this year, is un-der investigation.

The facility was under "lock-down" for six days while the pris-on and prisoners underwent an extensive search. The murder

weapon was found in the yard.

Frederick was the son of the late William Frederick, who served with the Farmington Township police from 1957 to 1965. The senior Frederick had moved to northern Michigan.

William Frederick Jr. had many scrapes with the law in Farmington Hills and was sen-tenced to five to 25 years in the Oct. 15, 1989, armed robbery of the Ram's Horn restaurant on Orchard Lake Road.
