

Internet has music information for all tastes

All you Beastie Boys fans, if you haven't already, will want to visit their home page on the World Wide Web. The Universal Resources Locator (URL) is <http://kafka.southern.com/BeastieBoys/>. Once there you will find tour dates, album covers, lyrics,

and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) about the Beastie Boys. The Beastie Boys also have a presence at the Music Kitchen, a WWW site with a pretty wide variety of singers. Others include Rodd Kross, Bonnie Raitt, the Wild Colonial, and Rock-It Comix. The Beastie Boys site at Music Kitchen includes a listening room with audio files, and a North American tour schedule. Bonnie Raitt's home page offers video clips, plus lyrics for 12 of her songs. The URL for the Music Kitchen is <http://www.mando.net/music/gm>.

The home page for the Rolling Stones can be accessed on the Web at <http://www.stones.com>. Once there, users can visit the lounge, look at CD offers, a pic-

ture collection, read interview articles, download Stones video clips or Voodoo Lounge sound samples. A site that's loaded with information about concert dates is Music-Cal which can be accessed at <http://calendar.com/concerts/>. Music-Cal lists the dates and locations of concerts, festivals and other musical events around the world and allows promoters, record labels, venues and even fans to submit tour and other event itineraries. Upon arrival the user is invited to search the site's database for information by performer, city, state, county or type of music. Music-Cal also offers a link of listings by geography and another link offering listings by the performer's or conductor's

name. For music lovers with an ear for keyboard sounds, the MIDI home page is <http://www.echelon.tu.nl/midi/index.html>. MIDI-lovers will find several MIDI files, software, newsletters, and links to other MIDI home pages.

Record labels, news about music, music magazines and more can be found at the Internet Underworld Music Archive at <http://www.luma.com>. This site contains software to play clips and full songs plus music written by struggling artists whose stuff you won't likely hear on radio, TV, CDs or albums. This site can be easily accessed by taking Lynx or another browser to the O&E Online home page at <http://oconline.com> and scroll down to Greg's Hot List.

Guess I really can't write a column on Music on the Internet without pointing some of you to the Elvis Home Page at <http://sunsite.unc.edu/elvis/elvis.html>. Some of the stuff that was at this site earlier had to be removed because of legal problems with those in Nashville that hold the copyrights over the King's music. But there's still plenty here, including a tour of Graceland, pictures of Elvis' birthplace, memorabilia, readings, several links to other Elvis home pages, and Elvis Internet Sightings.

In the Internet world of music, many music listserv discussion groups are almost like electronic fan clubs. Listserv is a discussion forum conducted via e-mail where all the messages posted arrives in your mail-box and you respond through e-mail. When you subscribe to a listserv talk group you will receive a confirmation message. Keep that message because it includes instructions on how to

cancel your subscription, how to post messages, how to get a digest of messages, stop messages while you are on vacation, etc. The list of music listserv groups that follows gives the e-mail address used to join the group and the words to type inside your e-mail message area.

JOE JACKSON (remember "Steppin' Out" and "Is she really going out with him?"); send request to majordomo@princeton.edu and in message type "SUBSCRIBE Joe-Jackson" (without the quotes).

GRAHAM PARKER ("Local Girls," "Wake Up (next to you)" and "White Honey"); send request to majordomo@princeton.edu and in body write "SUBSCRIBE graham-parker" by your first and last name.

BOB DYLAN is for all lovers of Bob Dylan's work and music. To subscribe send request to listserv@ubvm.cc.buffalo.edu and in the body of message type "Subscribe HVY61-L" followed by your first and last name.

ADVERT-L is an unmoderated discussion list for fans of the United Kingdom group "Blur." Send request to listserv@netcom.com and in the message type "subscribe ADVERT-L."

DREAMPOP-L is an open discussion list for anyone interested in this type of music, bands like My Bloody Valentine, Slowdive, The Boo Radleys, Swervedriver, Lush, Pale Saints, Llyls, etc. Send request to listserv@netcom.com and in message write "subscribe DREAMPOP-L."

SAUDADES DO BRASIL is a list for sharing news and views on the music of Brazil which has a musical culture that blends influ-

ences of Portugal and Italy, Africa, and the U.S. The music is not only the bossa and samba but frevo, forró, jazz, rock, rap, and classical to subscribe send request to listserv@princeton.edu and in the message type "subscribe saudadesdobrasil" followed by your first name.

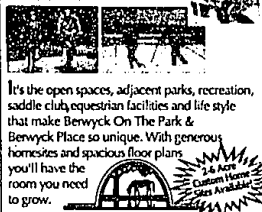
SINATRA is a discussion list on the music, arrangements, recordings, arrangers, movies, discographies, composers, lyrics, lyricists, and anything else involving the musical career of Frank Sinatra. Send request to listserv@princeton.edu and in the body of the message type "SUB SINATRA" followed by your first name and last name.

OPERA-L was founded in August 1990 to discuss opera and related topics. To subscribe send request to listserv@cu-nym.cuny.edu and in message write "sub opera-l" followed by your first and last names.

PIANO-L is a list for pianists and piano teachers. Topics include piano literature, memory and practice techniques, chamber music, pedagogical techniques, announcements, history and theory, performance anxiety, injury, composition, competitions, etc. Send request to listserv@uamont.edu and in body of e-mail type "SUBSCRIBE PIANO-L" followed by your first and last names.

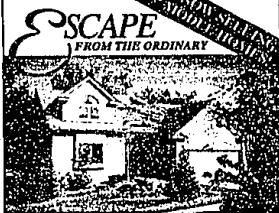
