Susan had her suspicions. It took a bout with pneumonia, and a dif-ferent pediartician, to finally have the correct tests ordered and to de-finitively diagnoss the condition as cystic fibrosis. It has affected Erin's lungs and pancreas.

"That darn pediatrician didn't selieve me," Susan said. "We must teep her lungs as free from infec-

tion as we can."
That involves daily treatments twice a day for the 5-year-old.


