

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT RUNS**  
Farmington Hills firefighters made 72 runs for the week of April 24-30, including 35 (49 percent) medical emergencies, seven rescues, seven fires and two downed power lines.

**BURGLARY**  
Assorted jewelry worth \$10,000 was stolen along with a \$2,400 laptop computer, \$300 Minolta camera, and \$140 cash in a burglary of a Heritage Village West residence in Farmington April 28. A checkbook and \$40 cash were stolen from a nearby Heritage Condominium residence the same day. In both cases, the front door was pried open. A person did see a blond-haired white male between the ages of 25 and 35 at the front door near the time of the theft.
