Survivors include three cousins, Ellen Oles, William (Phyllis) Sattavara and Helen (Russell) Peterson.

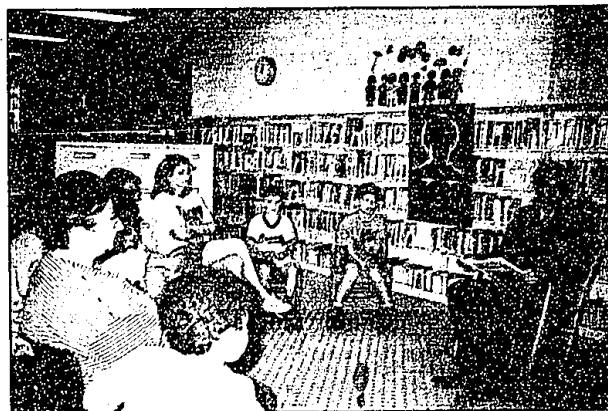

consignment. The show benefits Mothers of Multiples. For more information, call (313) 729-1234.

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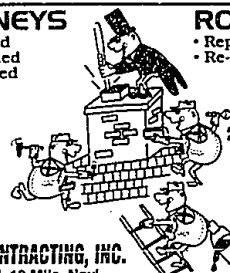

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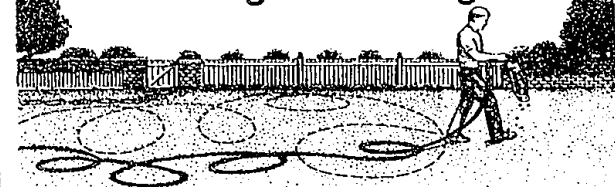

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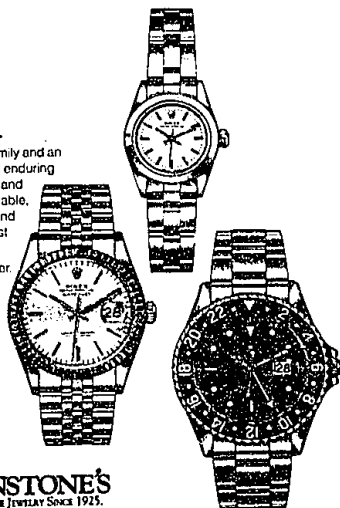
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
