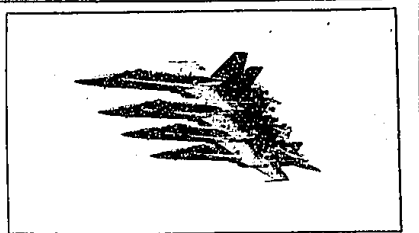
Blue Angels flying to Willow Run June 3-4
