

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

THEFTS

A blue 1994 Chevy Beretta (\$8,000) was stolen from the lot at the Target store on Grand River in Farmington Hills June 12.

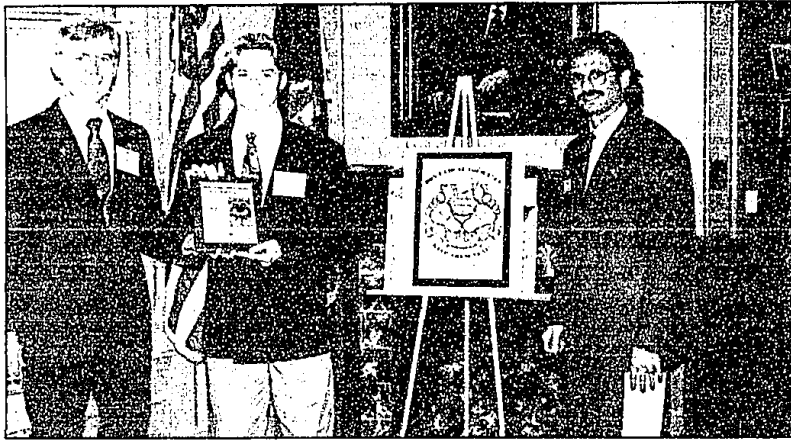
ACCIDENT

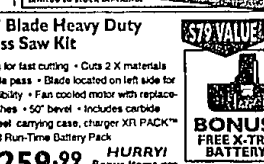
