

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

■ FIRES

Farmington Hills firefighters from Station 4 responded to a car fire at 2:01 p.m. June 21 on Kirk-side. The engine compartment of a 1983 Jeep had caught fire and was put out by the owner with a garden hose. The owner said the Jeep had been using a lot of oil and had just had engine work. The fire, which caused \$3,000 in damage to the Jeep and \$3,000 in damage to contents, started near the battery.

Station 3 firefighters put out a fire in a 1985 Mercury Cougar on 10 Mile at 7:34 p.m. June 23. The driver had noticed smoke and pulled the car off the road. The car burst into flames and was totaled (\$1,000). The car had recent engine work.

Firefighters from Station 2 put out a Dumpster fire at Mitchell's Carry Out on 12 Mile at 12:27 a.m. June 24. The fire caused \$200 in damage.

Station 2 personnel put out a Dumpster fire at the Inverly Condominiums on 12 Mile at 3:10 a.m. June 24. The fire caused \$500 in damage.

Firefighters from Station 1 responded to smoke at a residence on Gill at 10:08 p.m. June 25 and found that wiring had melted due to a short circuit and clothing inside the dryer had become charred. Damage was \$800.

■ FIRE DEPARTMENT RUNS

Farmington Hills firefighters made 87 runs during the week of June 19-25 including 41 (47 percent) emergency medical runs, four refuse fires, three car fires and three structure fires.

■ VANDALISM

A vehicle drove over the Independence Green Golf Course on Lincoln in Farmington Hills June 22-23 causing \$1,000 in damage to a green and \$1,000 in damage to a driving range net.
