An older woman approached band director Mark Phillips and told him she appreciated the group's rendition of "Satin Doll." It was the same number that played when she shared a dance with an American G.I. 50 years ago.

A visit to an American cemetery near Omaha Beach underscored the purpose of the journey. Scott Carpenter played taps while Dave Bjorklund and Estes laid a wreath during a ceremony to honor 10,000 U.S. servicemen who are buried there.

"Everything was real quiet. It was a real moving experience," said Bjorklund, who plays drums. "To the kids, that really hit home," Phillips said. "For something that happened 50 years ago. The kids really felt how important it was."

Performances in London and Heidelberg drew fewer spectators, but were not lacking for enthusiasm. In Heidelberg, Germany, the band played in a restaurant before 25 patrons.

Along the way, they ate everything from fish and chips to croissants to bratwurst. The educational menu wasn't lacking, either.

In Paris, students visited the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral and the Louvre where they impressed their tour guide with their knowledge of Greek mythology.

"Some of the buildings are older than our country," Estes said.

To raise money, jazz band members performed concerts, conducted a garage sale and had a
