For the Finesse 19-and-under softball slow-pitch softball team, it was a worthwhile trip last weekend to Rock Hill, S.C.

Coach Barry Patterson's squad captured the 27-team National Softball Association World Tournament with a 6-3 triumph in the finals over the Gwinnett (Ga.) Panthers.

Second baseman Vonne Jenks (Garden City High) made a diving catch with two runners aboard in the bottom of the seventh inning to preserve the victory and the title.

Finesse finished with a 6-0 record, including a first-round 5-3 win over the Georgia Bandits, who have won three of the last four U.S. Slow-pitch Softball Association age-group titles.
