strings are metal, which the player presses with the thumb to produce a melody while plucking the other forty strings for the accompaniment. Zither music has an ephemeral, etherwal sound in our opinion. The haunting rither music from the movie "The Third Man" made rither music familiar to recent generations, although it has been known to have been played as early as the 8th century. Further evidencing its tranguilling characteristics, in China the sin censury. We found little comparable prices in today's market, but we and our appraisers feel that it would be El The zither is a modern day version of the 15th century psaltery, which spreng from the santir, a 14th/15th contury vorsion of what later became the pizno. It falls into the chordophono family of isstruments in which sound is made by the vibration of strings. The zither is one of five instruments falling into that group, tho other four being the harp, lyre, bow and lute.
