## ON TRANSFER PACT

An agreement between Macomb Community College and Oakland University in Rochester Hills allows MCC students to complete a four-year degree at OU without losing credits. According to the pact, students will be automatically accepted at OU after successfully completing required classes at the community college.

Gary D. Russel, OU interim president, said the partnership will benefit both schools and increase educational opportunities to Macomb residents.

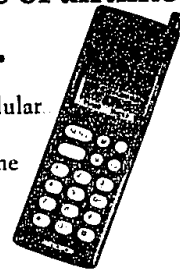
