Sluggish 'Dumbo Drop' has entertaining moments

Along with the elephant, they pick up an orphaned Vietnamese boy named Linh, played with winning assectness by 33-year-old Dinh Thien Le, who cares for the animal. The six make for a fun gang as they fumble and bumble through this generally innocuous adventure.

Besides the pacing problems, however, the film falters by including two scenes involving the elephant that seem gratitious and juvenile — one that has Capt.
